This will be conducted as per the conditions of tender and Instruction to Bidders Clause 7.1
2. Bulky tenders which do not fit in the Tender Box shall be delivered to the Supply Chain Management Office and registered.
3. All interested bidders are required to continually check the KeRRA website www.kerra.go.ke/tenders for any tenderers addendum or clarification that may arise before the submission date. Bidders who download the tender document must forward their particulars immediately to samburu.proc@kerra.go.ke to facilitate any clarification or addendums.
4. Errors in the pricing of the Bills of Quantities will not be corrected. Bidders with such errors will be disqualified.

5. Clarity on Serialization of Tender Documents

All pages of the tender documents submitted by bidders shall be sequentially serialized including the cover page.

6. Bidders are required to download full details of the advertisement and tender documents from the Authority's website www.kerra.go.ke or PPIP portal www.tenders.go.ke from 8TH January , 2026. At no cost.
7. All attachments must be certified by a commissioner for oaths.
8. The cost estimate of the proposed works has been provided in the tender document.
9. Completed tender documents are to be enclosed in plain sealed envelopes marked with Road Name and Tender number and deposited in their respective Tender Numbers Marked On the tender boxes situated at the Kenya Rural Roads Authority Regional Offices in Samburu-Maralal Town and be addressed to:
