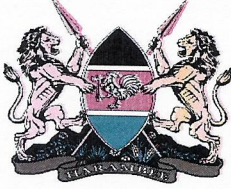

SPOT IMPROVEMENT AND ROUTINE MAINTENANCE WORKS IN NYAMIRA REGION

6. Pretender site visits will be conducted as per the conditions of tender and instructions to Bidders Clause 7.1. Pretender site visit arrangements will be between **27th -29th May, 2026**. Site visit certificates will not be signed beyond the indicated period.
7. All Interested bidders MUST provide **One (1) Original Tender Document**
8. All Interested bidders are required to continually check the KeRRA website www.kerra.go.ke/tenders for any tender addendum or clarification that may arise before the submission date.
9. Bulky tenders which do not fit in the Tender Box shall be delivered to the Supply Chain Management Office and registered.
10. Opening of the bids will take place immediately thereafter in the presence of the tenderers or their representatives who choose to attend.
11. Bids not received at the submission venue by the closing date and time will not be accepted for opening and will be rejected and returned unopened.
12. Errors in the pricing of the Bills of Quantities will not be corrected. Bidders with such errors will be disqualified.
13. The cost estimate of the proposed works has been provided in the tender document.
14. **Clarity on Serialization of Tender Documents**
All pages of the tender documents submitted by bidders shall be sequentially serialized including the cover page
