TENDER NOTICE

1. The Kenya Rural Roads Authority (KeRRA) is a state corporation established under the *Kenya Roads Act 2007*, charged with the responsibility for the management, development, rehabilitation and maintenance of Rural Roads across the country.
2. **The Authority** hereby invites bids from prequalified contractors within the Region and those in the special category (Youth, Women, and Persons Living with Disabilities -YWPLD) for Road Maintenance Projects for the Financial Year 2025/2026 under the contracts listed in the tender notice.
3. Interested bidders are requested to download the full advertisement details and tender documents **free of charge** from the following websites:

Mandatory Requirements

Bidders **must** meet the following requirements in addition to other conditions contained in the tender documents:

1. **Ongoing Works:**

To enhance equity, bidders with ongoing or incomplete works within the Region as of this tender closing/opening date are **not eligible** to participate in this tender.

2. **Pre-Bid Site Visit:**

The pre-bid site visit is **mandatory** and open to all interested bidders. Visits should be arranged in advance with the KeRRA Nakuru Regional Director's Office between **17th June 2026 to 26th June 2026**. After Site Familiarization, bidders are required to collect a **duly signed and stamped Pre-Tender Site Visit Certificate** from the following authorized Nakuru Region Roads Officers.

3. **Identification During Site Visit:**

Each bidder's representative must present the following during the visit:

- An official **introduction letter** from the company (on letterhead, signed, and stamped).
- An **original ID/Passport** and a **certified copy** of the same.

Photocopies or unsigned documents will not be accepted.

4. **Submission Format:**

Bidders must submit **one original tender document and one copy**.

5. **Bid Opening:**

Opening of the bids will take place **immediately after the closing time** in the presence of bidders or their representatives who choose to attend.

6. **Late Submissions:**

Bids received after the closing date and time (**Tuesday 30th June, 2026 at 10.00am**) will **NOT BE ACCEPTED** and shall be returned unopened.

7. **Award Limit:**

To promote equity, a bidder shall be **awarded a maximum of one (1) contract** under this Tender Notice, based on the most advantageous offers to the Employer.

8. **Director Conflicts:**

Directors bidding under multiple companies for the same tender will result in **disqualification** of all related bids.

9. **Pricing Errors:**

Errors in the Bills of Quantities (BoQ) will **not be corrected**. Bidders with such errors will be disqualified.

10. Serialization:

All pages of the tender document, including the cover page, must be **machine-serialized sequentially**.

11. Addenda and Clarifications:

All bidders are required to regularly check the KeRRA website (www.kerra.go.ke/tenders) for any **addenda or clarifications** issued before the submission deadline.

12. Market Rate Compliance:

To enhance competitiveness, bidders must ensure that their quoted rates in the BoQ are **within the prevailing market rates for road works**, pursuant to *Section 70(6)(b) of the Public Procurement and Asset Disposal Act (PPADA) 2015*, read together with *Regulation 43(4) of the Public Procurement and Asset Disposal Regulations, 2020*.

IMPORTANT NOTES

- Bidders shall submit certified true copies of all statutory, registration, and other supporting documents required under this tender. Certification shall be by a Commissioner for Oaths.
- The **cost estimate** of the proposed works is provided in the tender document.
- Tender documents detailing full requirements shall be available for download from the **KeRRA website** as from **15th June, 2026**.

SUBMISSION DETAILS

Completed tender documents, **duly serialized and properly bound** (tape or spiral binding), must be enclosed in **plain, wax-sealed envelopes** clearly marked with the **Tender Reference Number (e.g, KeRRA/08/NKU/....)** and **Tender Description**, and addressed to
