2. Director(s) bidding under different companies for the same tender will be disqualified.
3. There shall be a **MANDATORY** but open Pre-Tender Site Visits. Therefore, bidders are requested to make their own arrangements and familiarise themselves with the sites before tendering. All bidders who attend the site visits **MUST** sign pre-tender site visit register and obtain a pre-tender site visit certificate signed and stamped by the Regional Director.
4. For Purposes of signing the pre-tender site visit register and collecting pre-tender site visit certificates, the Bidder's Representative must have an official introduction letter from the Bidder.
5. Bidders **MUST** provide One (1) Original Document and One (1) copy.
6. All Interested bidders are advised to continually check the KeRRA website www.kerra.go.ke/tenders for any tender addendum and/or clarification that may arise before the submission date.

1. All attachments **MUST** be certified by a Commissioner for Oaths.
