Bidders are notified that this tender is prepared under the new Public Procurement Regulatory Authority conditions and format and criteria and ITT.

ALL FORMS MUST BE FILLED AND AUTHORISED APPROPRIETLY -NO UNNECESSARY ATTACHEMENTS

The Authority wishes to inform interested eligible bidders as follows

1. That the Invitation to Bid is open to Citizen Contractors only. The tender is open to all qualified and interested Tenderers who are Registered in the respective constituency .

2. Pretender site visit.

-All contractors are required to arrange for their own transport during the pre-tender site visit.

-Pre-tender site visit is mandatory. However, there will be no organized site meetings. The person representing a firm must have a letter of authorization

From the firm. A representative will Only represent ONE firm.

3. Bidders shall be required to provide the bid security as specified in ITT.

4. Detailed information on the tenders will be available for downloading **FREE of CHARGE** on the Authority's Website www.tenders.go.ke with effect from **8th June,2026**. Tenderers who download the tender document must forward their particulars immediately to turkana@kerra.go.ke to facilitate any further clarification or addendum.

5. Bidders are advised to regularly visit the KeRRA website for any information/addendums on the abovetenders.
6. Errors in the pricing of the Bills of Quantities will not be corrected. Bidders with such errors will be disqualified.
7. Submit a written power of attorney authorizing the signatory of the bid to commit the Bidder Executedby a Commissioner for Oaths, in accordance with ITT 21.3.
8. Completed tender documents should be enclosed in plain sealed envelopes, clearly marked with the Tender Name, Tender Number and be deposited in the respective tender boxes at the offices of RegionalDirectors on or before the dates indicated above for various tenders at 11.00 a.m. on the address below.
9. Bidders should have their documents paginated (serialized) to ensure compliance with section 74 (1) (i)of the Public Procurement and Asset Disposal Act, 2015. This should be in the format 1,2,3,4,5 from the First Page up to Last Page) Machine serialization is encouraged.
10. Opening of the bids will take place immediately thereafter at the respective addresses **in the presence of the tenderers or their representatives who choose to attend.**
11. Bids not received at the submission venue by the closing date and time will not be accepted for opening, will be rejected and returned unopened.
12. Qualified and interested tenderers may obtain further information and inspect the Tender Documents at KeRRA Regional Offices during office hours [0900to 1500 hours] at the address given below.
13. Tenders shall remain valid for 210 days from the date of opening of tenders.
